The Giving Project is an innovative model for building power. We achieve this through community organizing, leadership development, and funding social change. In the last four years, 100 Giving Project participants raised over \$660,000 to support social justice organizations across Minnesota.

No prior experience with philanthropy or fundraising is necessary—we train and support you along the way! The Giving Project will be a multi-racial, cross-class cohort. Black, Indigenous and people of color, LGBTQ-identified people, and low or no-wealth individuals are especially encouraged to apply.



Next Steps:

- Fill out the online interest form on our website! We will accept and review submissions throughout the fall. The priority deadline is Thursday, October 31st.
- We will contact potential participants within two to three weeks for a one-to-one conversation with a Giving Project alumni or Headwaters' staff member.
- We will notify you during the week of December 9th about where you have been selected for the Giving Project or have been placed on a waiting list for a future cohort.
