Our Leadership Definitions

Traditional leadership: Decisions regarding budgeting, goal setting, strategy, etc. are made by a leader or leaders defined by a hierarchical structure.

Decentralized (shared) leadership: Decision making is more participative. It's shared across the organization according to defined roles and may be based in consent or consensus.
